



Emergency School Closing Procedures/REMOTE LEARNING PLAN

CSI operations may be reduced, suspended or closed due to weather conditions, facility damage, or other emergency conditions that prevent normal operations.

The decision to reduce, suspend, or close all or part of the school for reasons of weather, building conditions, disruptive actions, or health risks will be made by the Executive Director or his/her designee. CSI will follow MPS plans, however, may have additional schedule alterations.

In cases of complete or near complete closure or shut down, the District's website <http://www.mpls.k12.mn.us> and local news media will be used under normal circumstances for notification purposes. The first notice will be posted on the District's Home page, and the school will make every reasonable attempt to notify local news media by 6 a.m. in such instances. If complete closure is required due to facility damage, or other emergency conditions all staff will be notified as soon as possible with proper instruction regarding the workday schedule.

All closures will be determined by the Executive Director.

Teachers will have their remote/digital learning days posted in Google Classroom and posted on the school webpage. Links are provide Teachers must share and review the plans at the beginning and throughout the quarter. Plans will be reviewed quarterly.

Staff will make contact with students on remote/digital days that are on their "Check and Connect" caseload. Staff not making contact will not be paid for the day. Staff will submit a roster and notes on interactions at the beginning of the day immediately following the remote learning day.

Staff will communicate throughout the day with staff via TEXT using Google Phone Numbers.

Staff will communicate with students throughout the day using TEXT and then student emails.
